SURI HALTER CLASSES

The following apply to all Suri classes irrespective of the size of the show.

Splitting of classes

All classes over 20 animals are to be split evenly from youngest to oldest. (Example: 30 Junior White Females — remove class 201 and replace with 201A — 15 alpacas & 201B — 15 alpacas. Sorted from youngest in 201A to oldest in 201B).

No Suri is eligible to compete for Championships in Huacaya classes.

Grey/Roan classes are to be judged together except at National, Royal and Colour Championship (Colourbration) Shows where the Grey/Roan class is split into a Roan Class followed by a Grey Class (both halter and Fleece).

HUACAYA HALTER SECTION

No Huacaya is eligible to compete for Championships in Suri Classes.

Splitting of Classes

All classes over 20 animals are to be split evenly from youngest to oldest. (Example: 30 Junior White Females — remove class 101 and replace with 101A — 15 alpacas & 101B — 15 alpacas. Sorted from youngest in 101A to oldest in 101B).

Grey/Roan classes are to be judged together except at National, Royal and Colour Championship (Colourbration) Shows where the Grey/Roan class is split into a Roan Class followed by a Grey Class. (both halter and Fleece).
